


George Boyce a member of the Town Fire Commission Board was present to report that:

1. Max Domras has resigned from the Board of Fire Commission.
2. Max Domras has been appointed as Sec. & Treas. for Town Fire District to fill the unexpired term of James Jenkins.
3. Wilbur Wheeler has been appointed to fill the unexpired term of Max Domras on the Town Fire Commission Board.
4. George Boyce was appointed as chairman of the Fire Commission Board to fill the position vacated by Max Domras

Mr. Boyce asked the Town Board for permission for the Citizens Hose Co. Inc. to construct a 50x75 addition to the present building. It will conform to the present architectural design. Cost of construction and maintenance will be the sole responsibility of the Citizens Hose Co. Inc.

The following resolution was moved by R. McCandless seconded by D. McIntire.

RESOLVED: That the Town Board of the Town of Urbana gives permission to the Citizens Hose Co. Inc. to build an addition to the present building of 50x75. This addition is to correlate with the present architectural design. This is contingent upon the Citizens Hose Co. Inc. providing adequate insurance; naming the Town of Urbana as the insured, also indemnifying the Town of Urbana against any Mechanics Leins. Carried. All voting aye.

D. Bailey discussed the motion of the January 8, 1982 meeting to Blacktop the Grayton H. Taylor Memorial Drive. After Mr. Blades & Mr. Bailey looked the road over in its present condition the base is not adequate enough to hold black top. Mr. Bailey feels that at \$49,000.00 a mile for black top that it would be a waste of money and that oil & stone would be sufficient at a cost of \$14,000.00 a mile. This will be discussed further.

Mr. Bailey also brought before the Board a request from Gold Seal to pave the road from 54A to the bottom of Urbana Hill Rd. Gold Seal is willing to pay for the majority of the cost. The cost will be \$7,150.00 of which the Town will pay \$1,150.00

D. McIntire made the motion that the Town of Urbana agrees to pay \$1,150.00 towards the paving of the lower portion of the Urbana Hill Road. Seconded by C. Kohl. Carried. All voting aye.

It was discussed that the Town of Urbana should be named as insured on the policy that the Hammondsport Little League has thus protecting The Town of Urbana from any liability.

Mr. Bailey brought to the Boards attention that a portion of the Damoth-Longwell Road in said Town has not been travelled or used as a highway for a period of six(6) years last preceeding.

D. McIntire made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 13 meeting. Seconded by L. Perkins. Carried. All voting aye


